Batch 2019-2022

Introduction

The Graduand batch 2019-2022 of 679 students had the unique and quite a rare experience of getting used to virtual classes via G Suite online classes which we had already in partial usage, from their homes from their 2nd semester to their 5th semester due to the pandemic Covid 19 that disrupted the world at large, and the academic life of students all over the world, and students were on campus only for 4 semesters, and that too was discontinuous due to a series of lockdowns as per the government's guidance. The college encouraged online academic activities and we tried our best to create opportunities for students' welfare and academic growth.

This is a brief edition of our activities and programmes organised by our students and teachers during these three years, apart from events that were organised by the departments and college. A detailed version has been sent to all our staff and students in pdf format. Before we get to the report, let us review the achievements of CTTE Trust that runs six educational institutions in Tamilnadu and Kerala.

The Chevalier T. Thomas Educational Trust is a pioneer in the private education sector, committed to quality education. It was established in 1965 by Chevalier T. Thomas. He founded the prestigious St. Mary's Schools. There are five schools in Perambur, Redhills and Kodungaiyoor that helped to upgrade the social processes and economic activity in the industrialized North Madras. Chevalier T. Thomas Educational Trust or CTTE Trust also founded a school

in Kottayam, the birth town of the founder Chevalier T.Thomas. Chevalier T. Thomas Elizabeth College for Women was established in 1985 by the then Correspondent Mrs. Elizabeth Thomas, the wife of late Chevalier T. Thomas with the purpose of empowering women. We are the first Self-financing College affiliated to the University of Madras and more than 14,000 students have graduated till now.

The CTTE Trust became a Public Trust in December 2002. Honourable Justice Thiru J. Kanakaraj, Retired Judge, High Court, Madras was appointed by the High Court of Madras as the Chairman of the Trust from 2002. The scheme was framed on 5.12.2002 by the High Court of Madras. The Trust took charge in 2003 under the Chairmanship of Thiru J. Kanakaraj, Retired Judge, High Court, Madras. He, with the able support of our Managing Trustee and Correspondent Mr. L. Palamalai, IAS retired, took up the tough and challenging job of developing the academic institutions under the Trust. Presently the CTTE Trust is under the able stewardship of Honourable Justice Thiru. B. Gokuldas, Judge (Retd.) Madras High Court who is the Chairman.

The Innovation Cell under the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, has given 4 stars to our institution for undertaking various activities to promote Innovation and Start-ups.
- Our Institution was selected by MHRD's National Mission of Education through ICT along with IIT, Bombay, to carry forward NMEICT Online Computer Skills Training.
- The NPTEL local chapter of our college has been selected by MHRD as the fifth best New Local Chapter in India.
- The ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu has selected our college as one among 50 colleges in Tamil Nadu to receive the Amazon Web Services Educate Member status. This will enable our college to receive services such as branding and training of faculty and students in Cloud Technology.

Association with Institutes of National Importance

- The college signed an five year MoU with CSIR- Institute of Minerals and Materials Technology on 09/09/2021, under the Maitri Initiative, for promotion of collaborative research, innovation and knowledge sharing.
- A One Week Faculty Development Programme on Innovation and Intellectual Property Rights was conducted from 4/10/2021 to 10/10/2021 and One Week National E-Workshop on Rural Techpreneurship Development was conducted from 15.12.2021 to 21.12.2021

- The college is a life member of ICTACT Academy of Tamilnadu, under which several FDPs, Expert Talk Series and Power Seminars were conducted for the faculty and students especially during the COVID lockdown.

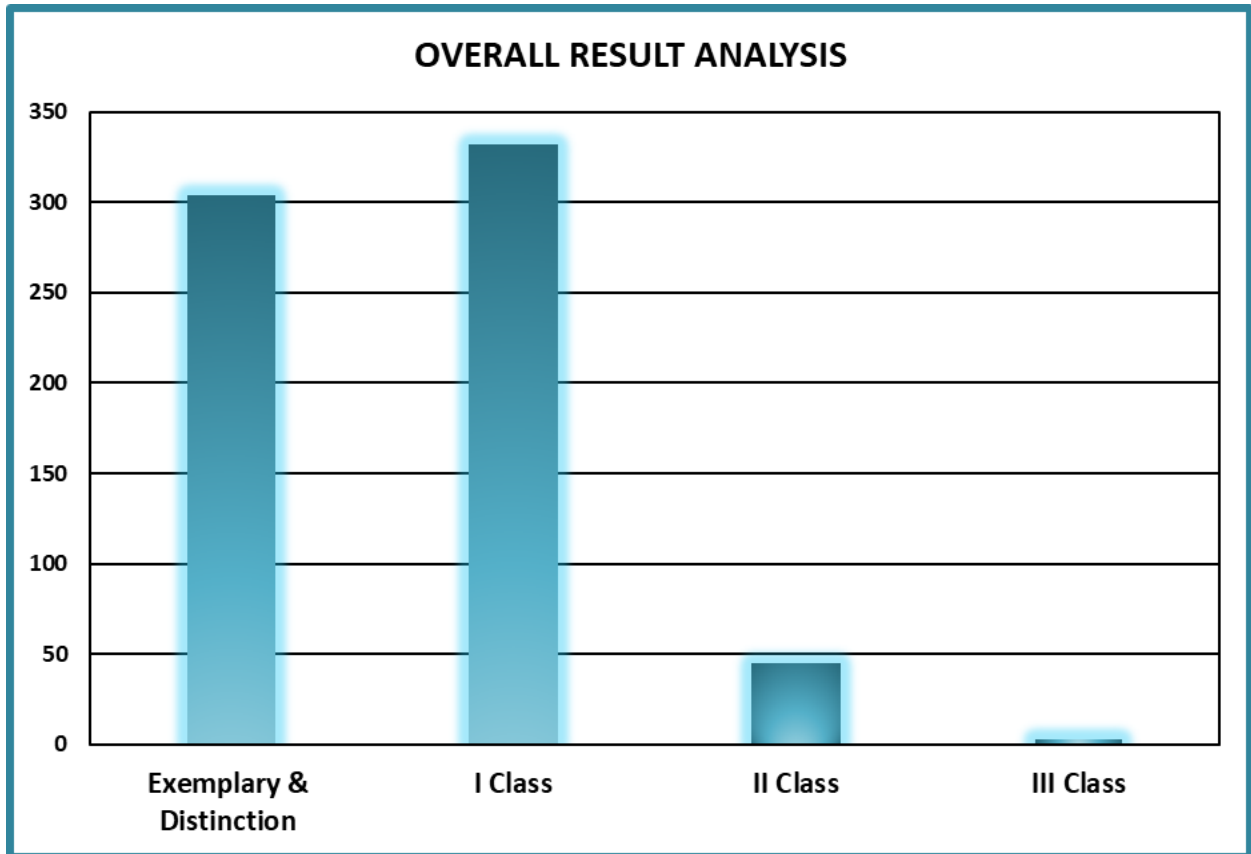

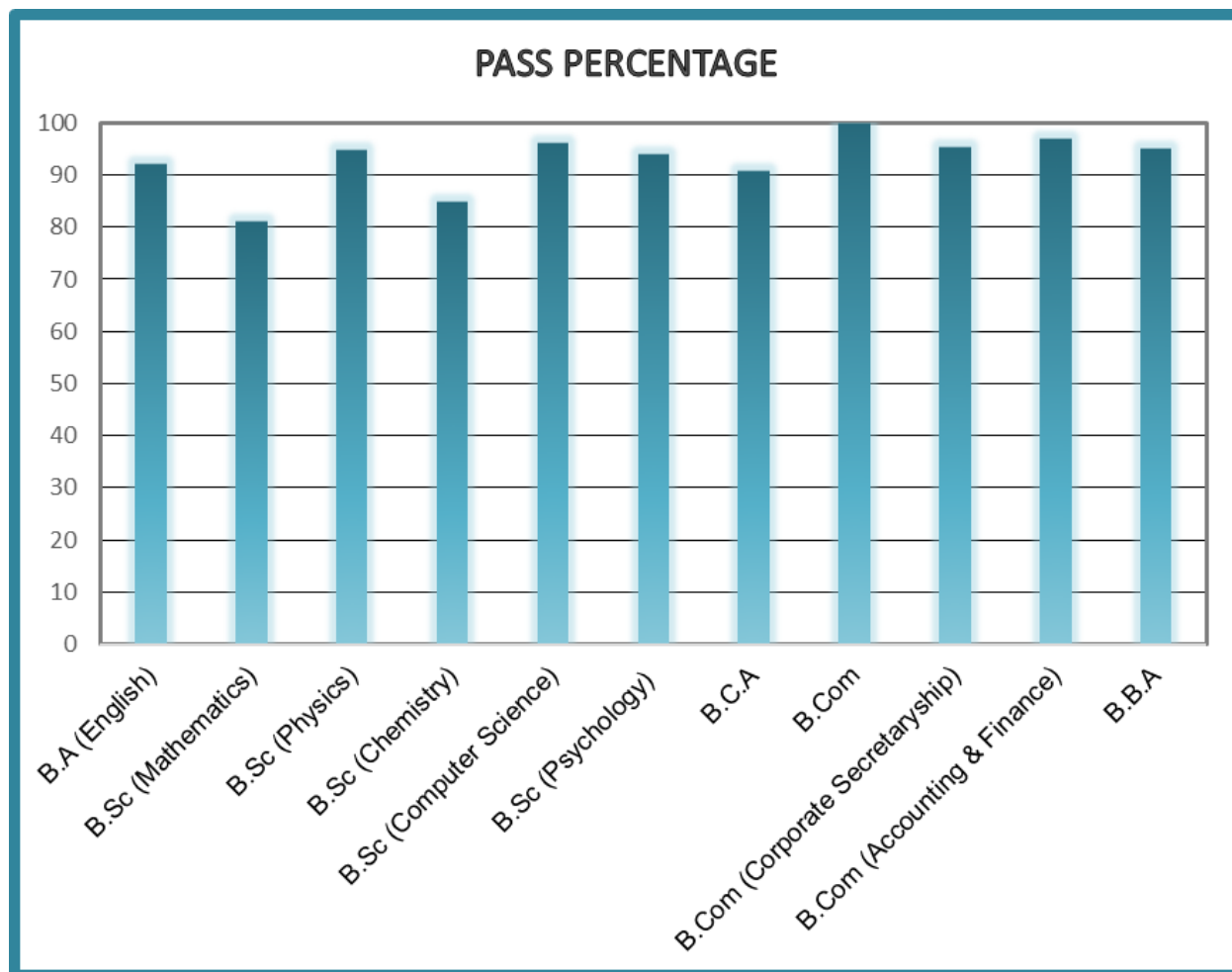

The University of Madras has a curriculum that aims at experiential learning and insists on internships, projects and training. 259 students from this batch in three years took up **internships/ Institutional Training/ Projects** in several institutions such as Port Trust, libraries in Chennai, Cancer Institute (WIA), Private companies, Corporate offices, auditing firms, publishing houses etc.

Women in career is our aim and the college encourages students to aim for a career. Departments support their students to get suitable jobs or guide them to get enrolled in higher education for PG courses. Some of our ambitious students get jobs through their internships and some get jobs through direct applications. Apart from these, our placement cell arranges placement training and placement drives. 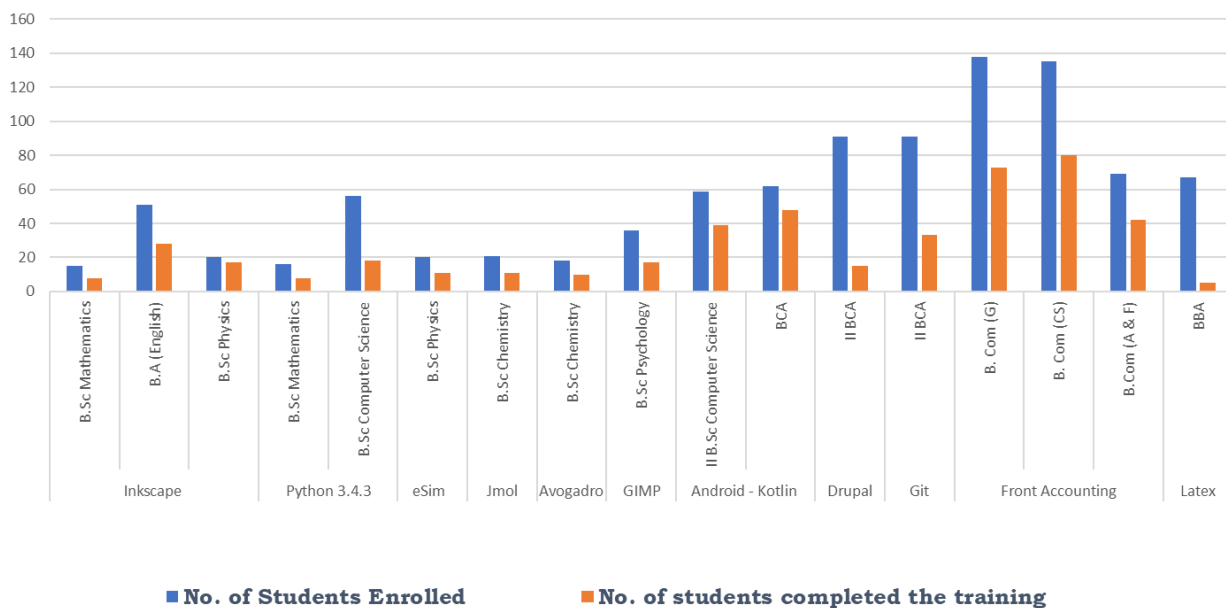

- National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology [NMEICT]** offers courses to students that are relevant to their programme, as well as extra-disciplinary courses such as Avogadro- advanced molecule editor and visualizer designed for cross-platform use in computational chemistry, Inkscape - quality vector graphics software, Git - free and open source distributed version control system, Drupal - open-source web content management system, Latex -a software system for document preparation, Front Accounting -2.4.7- professional web-based Accounting system, Python 3.4.3, GIMP- GNU Image Manipulation Program graphics editor etc. There are totally 50 courses offered in our computer labs to the students and are free, as the College pays for these courses to the government. These courses are conducted in collaboration with IIT Bombay and 463 students have completed these courses under the scheme - technology enabled learning.



- The National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (**NPTEL**) was initiated by seven Indian Institutes of Technology - the IITs (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Guwahati and Roorkee) along with the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 2003. The objective is to enable students to obtain certificates for courses and to make students employable in the industry or pursue a suitable higher education programme.
- There were **759 registrations for various NPTEL courses** such as Cost Accounting, Developing Soft Skills and Personality, Introductory Organic Chemistry I, Python for Data Science, Solid State Physics, History of English Language and Literature, Introduction to Chemical Thermodynamics and Kinetics by our students in the batch 2019-22.

Apart from the above mentioned Union Government's online courses, **Certificate Courses** are offered by our college and our students participated actively in these courses too.

Mathematics for Competitive Examinations

The Department of Mathematics offered a certificate course on "Mathematics for Competitive Examinations" for final year UG students for the academic year 2021-2022. In this certificate course 205 students were enrolled. There are two batches that have been conducted simultaneously from 20.10.2021 to 2.11.2021 by faculty members from the Department of Mathematics.

To empower the students facing the challenges in the technological world and also to create more technological job opportunities TECHNOLOGY ENHANCED TEACHING AND LEARNING (TETL) offered the following certificate courses to our students: Advance Python, Basic Excel for Science and English for workplace.

Programs for different types of learners

- Advanced Learners are encouraged to enrol in certificate courses run by NPTEL and specific courses such as EDGE-ON Plus offered by the English Department.
- Workshops are conducted to benefit both the Advanced and Slow learners. 13 Workshops were conducted and some of them are: Language Through Literature - Workshop for Advanced Learners, Recent Trends in Chemical and Materials Sciences and State Level Workshop on 'Molecular Modelling Tools'.
- 29 Webinars/Seminars were also organised with the same objective.
- The learners are categorised by continuous assessment in class, and the necessary steps are taken by faculty members as per needs.

Partnership In Language and Learning [PILL] is collaborative learning by mixing different types of learners. This initiative is in the hands of student leaders and has brought forth young academic leaders, slowly empowering young women.

Knowledge Resources

The College Library has a total of 30,000 books and reference materials. Dspace, a Digital Institutional Repository Software, was installed and uploaded with College and Department Publications. UGC-Inflibnet (N-List Programme-National Library and Information services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content") facility is available in college, and the passwords are given to all the students to use lakhs of e-resources free. These e-resources are on all the disciplines viz. Pure Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities including Linguistic and Languages. National Digital Library of India [NDLI] is also available freely for our students. The college has British Council online

membership for students. There are journals like Sage online Management Journal and Civil Service India e-Magazine, available for students. The Library has a Book Bank for the needy students and more than 600 textbooks books are in circulation for this purpose. Approximately, more than 200 students benefit from this scheme.

Teachers

Our faculty members are very conscious of their academic excellence and are invited for guest lectures, valuation, curriculum development across the state. They present papers in conferences and publish research papers regularly. They also continuously upgrade themselves by participating in FDPs, Refresher Courses, NPTEL courses etc.

We have a Book Bank for the needy students and more than 600 books in circulation for this purpose.

Our students participated in MHRD's Swachh Bharath Summer Internship and implemented various intervention activities in 3 villages of Thiruvallur District.

The NSS volunteers have begun an initiative "CTTE Green Campus". During the pandemic they took care of the college greenery.

It is heartening to note that an alumna from (BCom CS) has given feedback that in an interview she was asked to talk about herself for 1 minute and she chose to share her experiences in the NSS which impressed the interviewers tremendously. This enabled her to secure a seat for her post graduation amid tough competition.

We provide free Competitive Examination Training, Bank Coaching, as well as free Dance and Veena classes. Free software training is provided under NMEICT.

Dr. Elizabeth Thomas Memorial Scholarships are given to meritorious students for one student from each programme. The Management encourages academic excellence by giving proficiency prizes to students who excel in academics. Rank-holders in the University are given cash awards of Rs.5000/-,Rs.3000/-, Rs.2000/- and Rs.1000/- for the I, II, III & IV to X ranks respectively.
