

RULES & REGULATIONS

The College believes in discipline, commitment & hard work. We have laid down a few rules for students to follow & benefit from



Students must be punctual and attend the morning assembly every day. Habitual latecomers will have to face disciplinary action.

Students must be regular to classes and meet the requirement of 85% attendance.

Students must involve themselves in academic and co-curricular activities and engage in projects, present research papers, compete in competitions, organise programmes etc to foster creativity and build essential skills.

Students must avoid using indecent, unparliamentary language and are encouraged to use English on campus.

Students must wear modest clothes and wear their ID Cards at all times on the College Campus.

Students must keep the campus, classrooms, and restrooms clean.

Cell phones must not be seen in use on the college campus without appropriate permission. **The college will not take responsibility for any loss of cell phones or related gadgets.**

- Students who carry a cell phone must be mindful of disturbances and strictly keep it on silent mode.
- Students must respect privacy and avoid taking photos or videos of individuals without their consent.
- *Students must not share sensitive information via text or social media.*

Students are discouraged from wearing gold ornaments or carrying money and other valuables to college. **The college will not be responsible for any loss of personal belongings.**

Students are prohibited from indulging in ragging. A **Black Box** has been provided in front of the Principal's room for complaints regarding ragging. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities the concerned student will be given a chance to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, she will be expelled from the institution. Students who may face any instance of ragging are advised to send a mail to the grievance redressal committee.
