

The academic year 2024–2025 at Chevalier T Thomas Elizabeth College for Women has been marked by a sustained commitment to academic rigor, personal development, and community service. As an institution dedicated to the advancement and empowerment of women, the college has continued to uphold its legacy of Holistic Education through Values, Knowledge, Skills, Quality and Life Long Learning through a diverse array of curricular and co- curricular initiatives.

Academic activities throughout the year were characterized by a dynamic engagement between faculty and students. A series of Conferences, seminars, and workshops facilitated by eminent scholars and professionals contributed to an enriched academic environment and provided opportunities for interdisciplinary learning and critical inquiry.

In the co-curricular domain, the college organized a number of cultural festivals, literary events, sports competitions, and intercollegiate meets. EMPLOYABILITY
