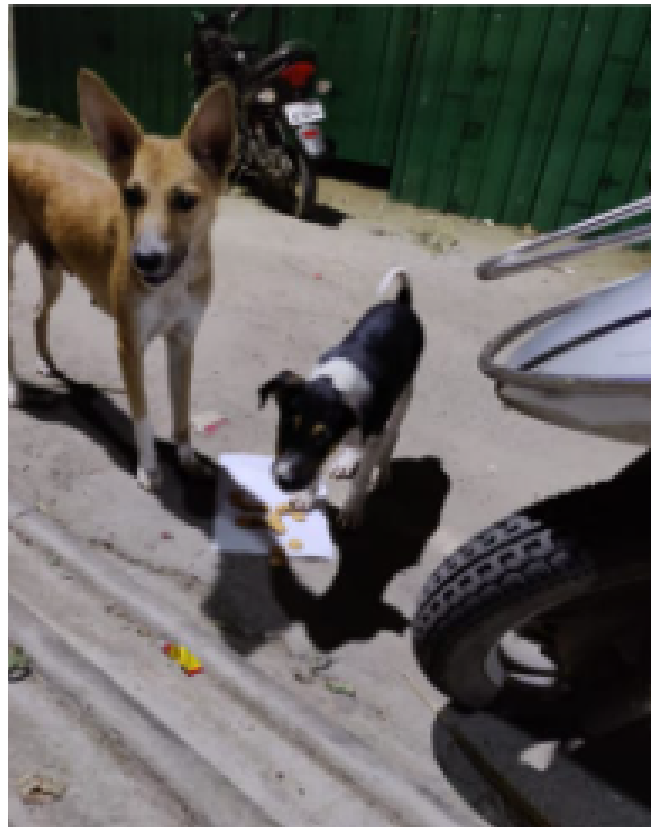

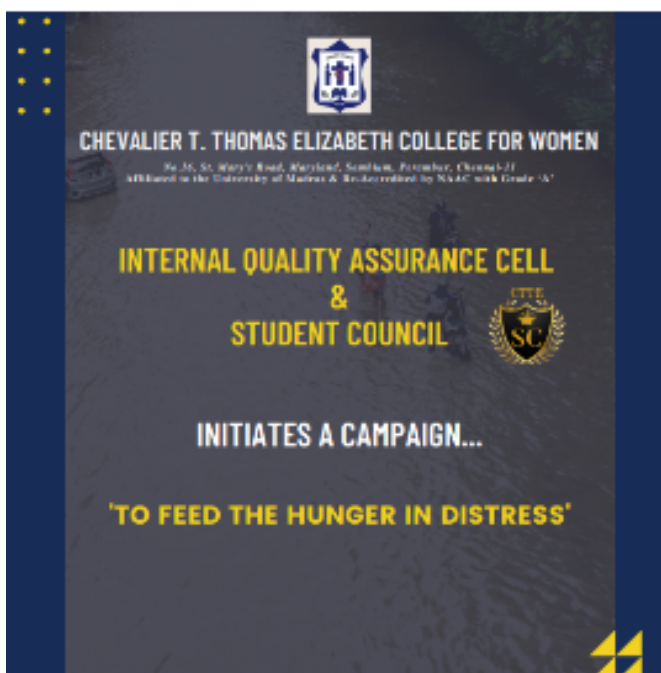

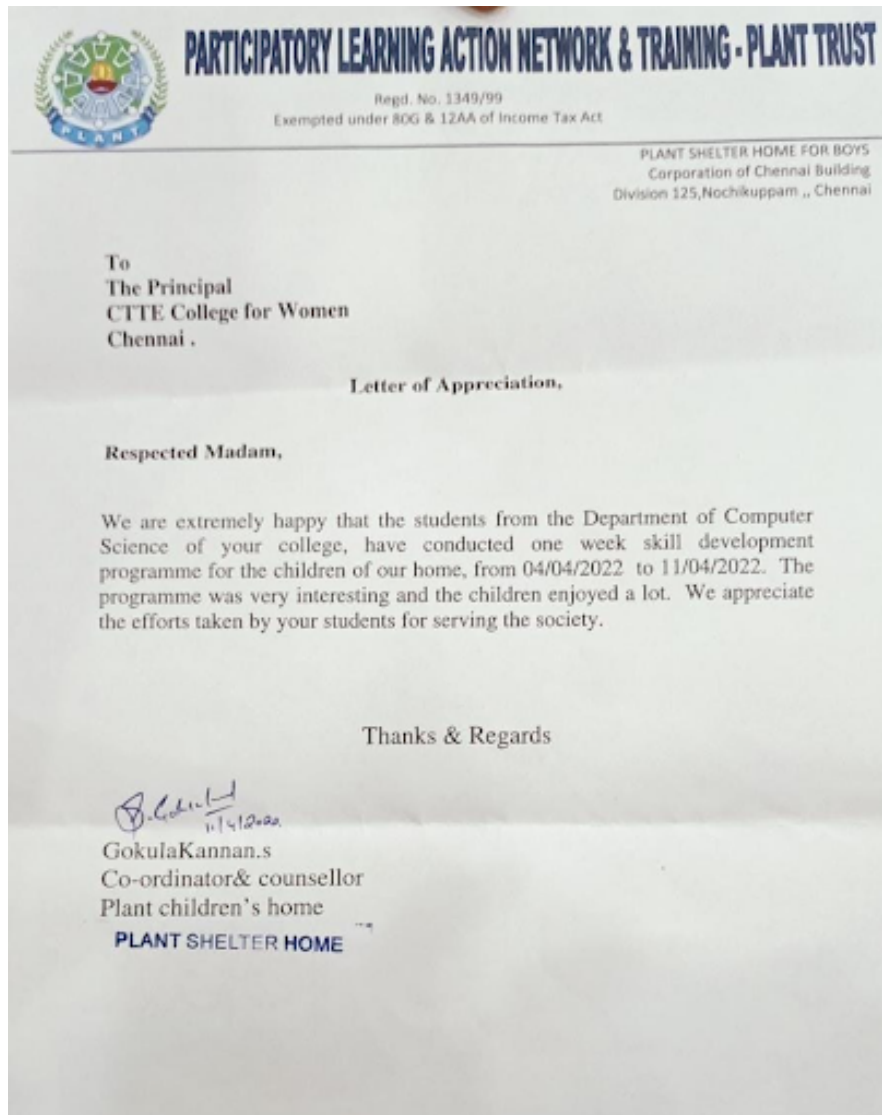


Day 7 (11.04.2022)
